AIRFIELD ESTATE FARM

IRISH FAMINE EXHIBITION

The Irish Potato Famine was the most catastrophic event in Ireland's turbulent history. This five-star Exhibition tells the story of what happened during those horrific years. The museum uses rare 19th century photographs, witness accounts, contemporary sketches, a 15-minute movie as well as maps and statistical information to tell this tragic story.

THE GUINNESS STOREHOUSE

The Guinness Storehouse is Ireland's number one visitor attraction. The tour lasts about 90 minutes and finishes up on the seventh floor, in the Gravity Bar with some spectacular views of Dublin and of course, a complimentary pint of Guinness, beer or soda.
